The majority of our working puzzle pieces comes from the donation of time. Other puzzle pieces include every retreat weekend receives donations of food and supplies that are used for and on the weekend. What about the other costs that we incur so that we can continue to offer this experience to others? Here is a breakdown of other

annual costs we have as an organization:

- CCLI license renewal \$ 273 - this allows us to provide music on the weekends
- Web Page Domain (.com & .org) Renewal \$ 23
- Warden's supply trailer apx \$ 300
- Fishes and loaves Coin necklaces apx \$225 - varies to how many participants

We also have other costs: reimburse home team for pictures and other items purchased that are needed for the weekend along with any other items on the wardens need list not donated by a team member. Occasionally we need to replace storage tubs that wear out or replace supplies for the Ultreya tubs for our summer picnics and other gatherings.

Did you know that a retreat weekend has an average cost of \$7,000 just for the camp or apx \$156.00 per person without our other operating costs?

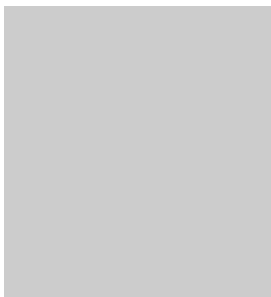
