Secretary

- ◆ Take minutes and record motions at all meetings and proceedings of the Board.
- ◆ Maintain and distribute the minutes to Board members for review and approval.
- ◆ Perform such other duties as required by the Board.

Membership Coordinator : two year term

- ◆ Maintains name of all that have worked prior weekends and their positions.
- ◆ Maintain database of current and past Koinonia members and distributes the list periodically.
- ◆ Provides this list at each weekend and also roster of new Koinonians on each weekend.

(Database is already created).

- ◆ Maintain a mailing list of other Koinonia-related ministries across the United States and beyond, and corresponds with these ministries to provide support and to encourage the sharing of spiritual growth and God's love. On the Koinonia weekend, provides the Wardens with letters from other Koinonia groups who have written to express support.

Membership Communications

- ◆ Provides the Koinonia family with information of all upcoming events, to include: Ultreyas, Koinonia weekends, Palanka Parties, Rezo de Sabado, etc. This communication is made through e-mails. Unless requested we do not mail out information.
- ◆ Twice a year a newsletter is sent out, usually before each Koinonia weekend, which contains pertinent scheduling information of events and may also contain maps, weekend registration forms, positions available on the Board, team lists, participant names and addresses and/or address changes.
- ◆ Makes several hard copy newsletters for Forth Day Packets on weekend and anyone requesting a hard copy.
