Have you ever wondered what goes on behind the scenes? How and when all the major decisions are made so our weekends can continue? Good news, we have open positions on the Continuance Board of Directors. Here is an overview of the responsibilities of each open position:

- <u>Chairperson:</u> Presides over all meetings of the board, calls board meetings, oversees that orders and resolutions are carried out, signs any necessary instruments, maintains historical records for each weekend.
- <u>Site Coordinator:</u> Primary camp liaison, review and verify the contract and reservations are correct and paid promptly, makes reservations with camp for weekends and meal counts, confirms camp is ready for weekend, any other contact needed with the camp.
- <u>Property Coordinator:</u> Resource and contact for adding Palanka to inventory, provides storage space for Koinonia supplies, ensure that Wardens inventory sheets are updated and that copies get where they need to go, helps Wardens with inventory before and after each weekend to ensure supplies are accurate.
- <u>Music Coordinator:</u> Maintains list of musicians available for team, liaison for Ultreya musicians, coordinates payment and renewal of CCLI license, oversees the preparation of new music dealing with CCLI license.
- <u>Participant Coordinator:</u> Prepares, distributes, and receives registration forms, updates applications for every weekend, provides applications for team meetings, coordinates with sponsor about obligations to participants, mails out participant welcome letters, maps, and directions for weekend, gets accurate participant list to head Prayer Disciple and wardens.
- <u>Membership Coordinator:</u> Maintains names of all interested in being on team, data base recording all attendees of prior weekends and positions, Updates koinonia directory.

"I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength, that he considered me faithful, appointing me to his service." 1 Tim 1:12 NIV

A blog by Stephenie Zamora caught my attention the other day. In it she wrote:

"You were put here for a reason, with your unique personality, skills, passions, and point of view. You're meant to do unique work in this world. "And what's that?" you might be wondering... Show up and be you. Do what you're called to do. Follow your passions, speak your truth, and leave your mark. We're all put here with different personalities, passions, and skills. If you feel called to make art, then you were put here to make art. If you feel called to write, record, build, design, speak, or explore, then you were put here to do just that. We have to find what lights us up, and what we feel called to do, and do it"
